Curriculum Guide for Two-Year-Olds



Two-year-old children will be offered the following experiences:

Literacy

Language

- Conversation and talking
- Speaking in sentences
- Naming body parts, increasing vocabulary
- Responding to questions
- Encouragement in asking questions and relating experiences
- Describing action in pictures
- Repeating sentences, songs
- Telling name, age and sex

Visual Discrimination

- Matching colors
- Identifying colors by pointing
- Sorting objects by color, shape and size
- Identifying pictures

Auditory Discrimination

- Identifying environmental sounds
- Identifying animal sounds
- Repetition songs and story lines
- Repetition of 3 numbers or words

Math

Shapes

- Manipulation
- Naming
- Grouping
- Recognizing
- One-to-one matching
- Size concepts such as: short/long, little/big
- Spatial relationships such as: up, down, out, in, over, under, far, and near
- Counting groups of objects up to three

Writing

- Paper tearing
- Scribble drawing
- Using markers, crayons, paint brush
- Drawing circles and lines
- Beginning use of scissors
- Making clay ball, cakes and ropes

Motor Skills

Gross Motor

- Locomotion such as: walking, tiptoeing, running, jumping, moving to music, riding a tricycle, climbing
- Refining bathroom skills
- Managing clothing
- Balancing for a few seconds
- Rolling, bouncing, catching a ball, throwing, catching beanbag

Fine Motor

- Activities such as: stringing beads, play dough, folding paper, manipulating wind-up and screw toys, working inset and 5 piece puzzles
